The proposed bimonthly water rates represent an overall 5% rate revenue increase, and a simplification of the water rate structure to reflect the cost of service analysis.

**How will this impact a typical Single-Family bill?**

Sweetwater Springs utility rates are among the lowest in the area and will continue to be low with the proposed rate increases. Currently, a typical single family using 10 units of water bimonthly has a bill of \$106.23. The proposed rates will increase the typical bill by 5%, or \$5.30 bimonthly, for 10 units of water use. Greater water conservation will result in lower water bills.
